



Post Card Project

For the post card project, you will use the travel guides available in the library and/ or on the Internet to complete one of the following 4 options. Cards will be provided for you. For each card, the blank side will contain a picture of a Spanish-speaking destination. The lined side will contain information about that destination.

Option One- 4 post cards

For the 4 post card option, you will be allowed to print pictures from the computer (remember that the library charges 25 cents per page) and paste the pictures onto each card. The back of each card should have, written in your own words in English, a detailed paragraph of about 12 sentences giving information about the destination or attraction pictured on your card.

Option Two- 3 post cards

For the 3 post card option, you will be allowed to print pictures from the computer (remember that the library charges 25 cents per page) and paste the pictures onto each card. The back of each card should have (written in Spanish) at least 3-4 sentences giving information about the destination or attraction pictured on your card.

Option Three- 2 post cards

For the 2 post card option, you will be allowed to write your description in English (a detailed paragraph of at least 12 sentences), but the pictures on your post cards must be hand-drawn and colored. The picture does not have to be perfect, but must show enough effort to convince me that it took you an entire 96 minute block to complete.

Option Four- 1 post card

For the 1 post card option, you must hand-draw and color the picture for your post card and have (written in Spanish) at least 5-6 sentences giving information about the destination or attraction pictured on your card. Picture and paragraph must show enough effort to convince me that it took you an entire 96 minute block to complete.
